In conjunction with the Hamilton Municipal Code, Zoning Ordinance Title 17, Signs, Chapter 17.104, Sections 020, 040, 070, 150 and 155, and Title 12, Streets, Sidewalks and Public Places, Chapter 12.12, Sections 090 and 100, attached to this application, I, _____, property owner of _____ have read and understand the rules and regulations for this Encroachment Permit Request. It is understood and agreed that the property owner will defend and indemnify the City of Hamilton against any claim which arise out of or is based on the existence of the encroachment within the right-of-way. It is also understood and agreed that the City of Hamilton is not responsible for any damage to the encroachment which is a result of its location within the right-of-way.

The above described encroachment shall not be subject to addition, modification or renovations without prior approval from the City of Hamilton. Violation of any of these terms shall make this permit null and void.

Section 12.12.090 Encroachment--Permit required.

Any person or contractor requesting a permit to establish or maintain an encroachment into the public right-of-way of permitted items shall obtain an encroachment permit to allow for such encroachment. A processing fee shall be established by the city council by resolution and shall be paid by any applicant for any permit requested.

This will include Sidewalk or Ground Sign placement requestS. (Ord. 143 (part), 1999)

Section 12.12.100 Investigation fee.

- A. Investigation. Whenever any encroachment permit application has been submitted to the city an investigation of site shall be preformed by city staff to evaluate such request for an encroachment permit.
- B. Fee: The only fee applicable shall be the encroachment permit fee, which shall cover a site investigation for review of the permit request.

- ___ 8. Show distance from all structures to the property boundaries.
- ___ 9. Show existing and proposed curbs, sidewalks, driveways and entrances to structures.
- ___ 10. Indicate scale of drawing (1" = 20' preferred, 1" = 50' maximum).
- ___ 11. North arrow required.
- ___ 12. Provide legal description and/or address of property
(on plat map from County Clerk & Recorder).
- ___ 13. Show all easements and all easement dimensions.
- ___ 14. On Fence Permits show any existing fences and proposed fences and indicate height

Note: All Site Plans shall be designed in accordance with the City of Hamilton Ordinances and Design Regulations and the City of Hamilton Municipal Code.
