This Committee of the Whole meeting is being held in person. Due to public health concerns and Governor Directive, this public meeting will be limited to a maximum of 50 people. If more than 50 people attend, the meeting may be cancelled and rescheduled either electronically or in a venue where physical distancing can be maintained.

Per Governor Bullock's July 15, 2020 Directive, a mask or face covering that covers the mouth and nose at all times is required while entering or remaining in City Hall. This requirement applies in counties in which there are four (4) or more confirmed and active COVID-19 cases and at this time, Ravalli County has more than four confirmed and active cases. Mask or face covering use will be required at this Committee meeting for ages 5 and older. You may remove your mask at the podium while making public comment.

Appropriate physical distancing of 6 feet between non-household members should be maintained at the meeting and seating has been arranged to allow for this distancing.
